



## **AGREEMENT OF INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION**

The Department of History Society and Human Studies of the University of Salento (Italy), represented by its Director Prof. Fabio Pollice, and Higher School of Performing Arts Raikin (Russia), represented by its Rector Anatoly Polyankin, and the Russian Centre of International Theatre Institute represented by its General Secretary Alfira Arslanova and the Italian Centre of the International Theatre Institute, represented by its President Fabio Roberto Tolledi, and Astragali Teatro-Eufonia soc.coop., represented by its President Ivano Gorgoni, (hereafter referred to as the “contracting parties”), all acting on the basis of their respective statutes, considering that:

- the University is the main centre for research/social/creative activities and student learning; and other involved institutions are main centres for theatre production, education, training, promotion;
- it is their task to critically process and promote the spread of academic, educational knowledge, of social research, of performing arts practices, of material and immaterial cultural heritage;
- it is in the parties' interest to establish a long lasting relationship of cooperation and cultural exchange to be developed on national and international scale;

**agree on the following points:**



## ARTICLE 1. Application of the Agreement

1.1 The contracting parties, shall set up an Agreement of collaboration based on equality and reciprocal advantage. Not denying the possibility that other areas can be identified by mutual consensus in the future, the contracting parties define that cooperation may take place in the following areas and by the following means:

- set up of joint educational, cultural projects, on national and international scale;
- promotion of intercultural cooperation actions, with a special focus on social theatre;
- organization and implementation of educational and performative activities for students, teachers, experts, artists such as workshops, master classes, training courses, performances;
- exchange of researchers, experts, teaching staff, artistic staff for short duration courses;
- joint publications corresponding to the common interests of the contracting parties;
- organization of conferences, study meetings, seminars, and courses for students and staff;
- setting up of research and/or innovation projects in any area of common interest to the contracting parties

## ARTICLE 2. Approval

2.1. This Agreement of cooperation is approved in conformity with the laws and internal regulations governing each of the contracting parties and will come into force from the date of being signed. This same Agreement will last for five years and may be prolonged prior to its conclusion by means of resolutions by the Governing Bodies of each contracting party.

2.2. This Agreement may be amended by the mutual written consent of the parties at any time during the term of this Agreement.

2.3. Either of the parties may withdraw from the Agreement provided that they inform the other party in writing by registered letter with return receipt at least three months before the end of the Agreement. In all eventualities, both parties undertake to guarantee the regular completion of any activity in progress.

2.4. This Agreement of cooperation will be signed in two original copies in English, each of which shall be deemed to be an original and it shall not be necessary in making proof of this Agreement to produce or account for more than one such original.

## ARTICLE 3. Other Items

3.1. Each party to this Agreement shall be solely responsible for any and all actions, suits, damages, liability or other proceedings brought against it as a result of the alleged negligence, misconduct, error or omission of any of its officers, agents, or employees. Neither party is obligated to indemnify the other party, or to hold the other party harmless from costs or expenses incurred a result of such claims; and each shall continue to enjoy all rights, claims and defenses available to it under law.

3.2. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to give rights to any third parties.

3.3. For remaining matters, other documents can become appendices to this Agreement if both parties agree, sign and seal, and shall have the same effect as this Agreement






